



## What We Believe .....

Worship is not something that is limited to a set time each week, we want to make our very lives an act of worship to God. Worship is the key in which we play the whole of our lives.*

*We seek to learn from Jesus. As Christians, we have become disciples, literally, 'learners' of Jesus. This is a continuous process and isn't just about gaining head knowledge, but life-knowledge, as we journey in His company. We learn from Jesus through teaching on a Sunday, through small groups, through our own reading and prayer, and through our relationships together.*

*We seek to serve in the power of the Holy Spirit. As Christians we follow a servant God. And so it is a distinguishing mark of the Christian to serve. With the help of the Holy Spirit, we express this in all that we do in the Church, but also in all that we do as we seek to reach out to those beyond our Church with the Good News of Jesus.*
