## Children & Youth at MMBC

*Here at Melton Mowbray Baptist Church we seek to be an all-age church where people of any age are valued and considered part of the congregation. To this end we seek to arrange events and groups for specific ages.*

## A Variety of Groups & Events

*Some of our children's and youth activities and events include:*

### ***Parent & Toddlers***

*The parent and toddler group meet on Wednesdays during term time (and on occasional days during the holidays) from 9.30-11.15am.*

*It provides opportunity for parents, grandparents, guardians and child-minders to meet informally for coffee and fun.*

### ***RoundAbout Clothing Exchange***

*The RoundAbout Clothing Exchange is open when the Parent & Toddler group is meeting.*

*It provides second-hand toddler clothing at very low cost.*

### ***Holiday Club Weeks***

*During the year we hold two holiday clubs – one at Easter and one during the summer holidays. Both are for children in Year R to Year 6 and run usually from 10am through to 12 noon.*

*The clubs include craft, games, Bible stories, songs, competitions, prizes and lots more.*

### ***Rock Nite***

*Rock Nite meets once a month on a Tuesday evening from 7.30-9pm. It is for Year 7 to Year 9 – please check for dates and venues.*

### ***Sunday Mornings***

*In addition to all the above, there are crèche facilities on a Sunday morning as well as specific children and youth programmes running.*

*Our Sunday worship begins at 10am and we aim to finish roundabout 11.30am.*

## **Safe to Grow**

*As a church we are committed to the nurturing, protection and safekeeping of all – especially children and young people.*

*As part of this commitment all those who work or have any involvement with the children's and youth work at MMBC undergo regular checking with appropriate safeguarding agencies and all hold valid DBS certificates.*

*All workers are also encouraged to undergo relevant training, both from inside and outside the church, and agree to adopt the church's safe to grow policy.*

*The church membership have also appointed two people to work as child protection coordinators and a number of people to work as child advocates.*
